OUR STORY...

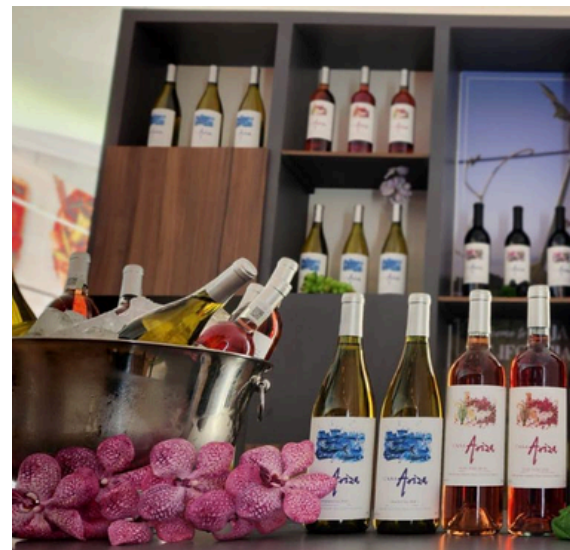
Casa Ariza is the result of a shared dream between two brothers, Jan and Curro, who set out to perpetuate the legacy and hard work started by their grandfather, Don Antonio Ariza Cañadilla, when he planted the first vines in the San Vicente Valley in 1979.

Guided by the teachings and wisdom of their grandfather, Jan and Curro explored new frontiers, growing their own organic vegetables in the United States and supplying heirloom vegetables of the highest quality to the best restaurants in San Diego and its surroundings. However, it wasn't until 2015 that they decided to take on the challenge of managing their grandfather's beloved vineyard.

Applying the knowledge they had gained in the field, and with the privilege of having 64 hectares of incredibly fertile red clay soil and abundant water, the brothers expanded and perfected the vineyard, producing some of the best grapes in Baja California.

At the same time, they began vinifying part of their grape harvest to explore the unique qualities of each parcel, highlighting varieties such as Sauvignon Blanc, Chenin Blanc, Chardonnay, Cabernet Sauvignon, and Ruby Cabernet. After five years of careful work, they gave life to their own brand that honors the legacy of their grandfather, who was the founder of Casa Pedro Domecq México.

This is how Casa Ariza was born, a project that blends a passion for wine with respect for tradition and a commitment to excellence.
