Winery



Bodegas de Santo Tomás is one of Mexico's oldest and most iconic wineries. Founded in 1888 in the Santo Tomás Valley of Baja California, it marked the beginning of commercial winemaking in the region. Although grape cultivation in the valley dates back to 1791, Santo Tomás was the first winery to produce and bottle wine on a commercial scale.



In 1939, under the ownership of Abelardo L. Rodríguez, the winery became the first in Mexico to bottle wine commercially. Over the decades, Bodegas de Santo Tomás has combined tradition with modern winemaking techniques, helping shape the identity of Mexican wine. Today, it remains a symbol of heritage, quality, and innovation in Baja California's wine industry.

The wines of Bodegas de Santo Tomás are recognized for their structure, balance, and expression of terroir. Produced from carefully selected vineyards across Baja California,
